Guitarist Pete McCann plays with a musky, hazy tone enabled by spidery fingering and an expansive knowledge of bop, post-bop, free jazz and Latin music. That he sounds so comfortable with any idiomatic reference makes his excellent third CD Most Folks an easy album to lie back with and spin the tumblers of your mind. Celebrating his new release at Chris', McCann will be accompanied by New York's finest, and I don't mean law enforcement. Alto saxophonist John O'Gallagher, drummer Mark Ferber and bassist John Hebert play with the same concentrated passion as McCann, the music perpetually swinging, stabbing and punching.
