

Pete McCann creates a wide swath of colors with his guitars with a team of Steve Wilson/ss-as, Henry Hey/p-key, Matt Pavolk/b and Mark Ferber/dr on this collection of originals. His guitar can be as cool as a cucumber with post bopping altoist Wilson on the sleek "Without Question" while rocking with some Hendrixy tones on "Conspiracy Theory". The tones are tender on a reflective "I Can Remember" and "Lost City" while nifty around Ferber's brushes on the bopper "Lovely Thing". Wilson gets the spotlight with Hey



on the resonant "Blues For O. M." and the team is warm on the dramatic "Erase The Hate", going exotic for the subtle pulsation of "Trifecta". Soulful strings.
